A walk through 200 years of Clarinbridge history led by Mark Green and Joe Murphy. In 1837 the Ordnance Survey mapped a village of over forty buildings in the townland of Gortard in Clarinbridge, a village which no longer exists. What happened to the houses, the people, the community? How did they live? Join noted local historian Joe Murphy and more recent Slieveaun resident Mark Green on a walk back in time.
