CONTENT OF SITE NOTICE

In accordance with Article 19 Planning & Development Regulations, 2001, as amended.

- 1 **The name** of the applicant for permission (not agent).
Type of permission sought (delete as appropriate)
 - Permission
 - Retention Permission
 - Outline Permission
 - Approval ie. based on valid outline application received before 11th March 2002 and subsequently granted. State Outline Ref. No.
 - Permission Consequent on the grant of outline. State Outline Ref. No.
- 2 **Location, Townland or Postal Address**
- 3 **The nature and extent of the development:**
 - If housing or apartments, state the number of houses or apartments.
 - If retention, (the present tense must be used) state the nature of the proposed use and period proposed to retain the structure, if appropriate.
 - If carrying out works to a protected or proposed protected structure, indicate that fact.
 - If an environmental impact statement has been prepared, indicate that fact.
 - If the activity requires an integrated pollution control licence or waste licence, indicate that fact.
 - If it relates to development in a strategic development zone, indicate that fact.
 - If it relates to development consisting of the provision of, or modifications to an establishment within the meaning of Part 11 of the Regulations, indicate that fact.
- 4/5 **That the planning application may be inspected** or purchased at the offices of the planning authority during office hours and a submission or observation in relation to the application may be made to the authority in writing on payment of the prescribed fee. (pre-inserted in template)

General Provisions on Site Notice

- Inscribed/printed in indelible ink, on white background,
- Be of rigid, durable material.
- Secured against damage from bad weather or other causes.
- Be securely erected/fixed in a conspicuous position on or near the main entrance or entrances from a public road, so as to be easily visible and legible by persons outside the land or structure or from the public road.
- You may be asked to erect further site notices as the planning authority may specify.
- Subsequent applications within 6 months on substantially the same or smaller site to be on **yellow background notice**.
- Notice to remain in place for 5 weeks and to be replaced if removed, defaced or illegible.
- Site notice to be removed after notification of planning decision.
