## INTRODUCTION

The village of Cill Rónáin is the principle village of Inis Mór , the largest of the Aran Islands. Inis Mór is a major tourist destination in the Region, Private minibuses, horse-drawn carriages and bicycles are the main methods of getting about for the numerous tourists who visit the island in the summer months

The objectives of the Cill Rónáin Traffic Management Plan are:

- Remove congestion.
- Enforcement of Parking Restrictions.
- Pedestrian Safety.

## PARKING

### **Proposed Parking Schedule**

Village of Cill Rónain, street or portion of street in which parking is prohibited at all times.

<b><u>No.</u></b>	<b><u>Name of Street</u></b>	<b><u>Portion of Street</u></b>
<u>1.</u>	Main Street (L52007)	From a point 30m north east of the pedestrian entrance to the pier continuing in a westerly direction for a distance of 186m on the southern side of the L52007.
<u>2.</u>	Main street (L52007)	From a point 6m south west of the new harbour entrance continuing in a westerly direction for a distance of 233m on the northern side of the L52007
<u>3.</u>	Main street ( L52007)	From a point on the eastern side of the junction of the L-5200 and the L-52007 heading in an easterly direction for a distance of 113m on the northern side of the L-52007
<u>4.</u>	Main Road ( L-5200)	From the junction of the main road L-5200 and the unclassified road where the spar supermarket is located. Heading in a southern direction for a distance 16m on the eastern side of the L-5200
<u>5.</u>	Main Road ( L-5200)	From the junction of the main road L-5200 and the unclassified road where the spar supermarket is located. Heading in a northern direction for a distance 14m on the eastern side of the L-5200
<u>6.</u>	Airport road (L-5200) & main Road (L-5200).	From a point 6m north of the junction of the airport road ( L-5200) & the Main Road ( L-5200) along the northern side of airport road for a distance of 44m .
<u>7.</u>	Airport road (L-5200) & main Road (L-5200).	From a point 17m south of the junction of the airport road (L-5200) & Main street ( L-52007) along the western side of main street for a distance of 18m, then continuing in a westerly direction along the southern side of the L-5200 for a distance of 42m .
<u>8.</u>	Main Street (L52007)	From the junction of the Main street ( L-52007) and the Slipway on the southern side of the L-52007 heading in a south westerly direction for a distance of 93m
<u>9</u>	Point Road (L-52007)	From a point 3m south of the junction of the Point road and the new harbour entrance, on the southern side of the Point Road for a distance of 47m
<u>10</u>	Point Road (L-52007)	From a point 70m south of the junction of the Point road and the Leachtagh Road, on the eastern side of the Point Road for a distance of 139m
<u>11</u>	Point Road(L-52007)	From a point 70m south of the junction of the Point road and the Leachtagh Road, on the western side of the Point Road for a distance of 132m

### **Proposed Loading Bay Schedule**

Village of Cill Rónain, Location Of Loading Bays.

<b>No.</b>	<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Portion of Street</b>
<u>14.</u>	Point Road (L52007)	From a point 30m north east of the junction of the Point road and the harbour entrance, on the southern side of the Point Road for a distance of 7m

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### Schedule 3

#### **Proposed Clear-Way Schedule**

Village of Cill Rónáin, Location of clearways.

<b><u>No.</u></b>	<b><u>Name of Street</u></b>	<b><u>Portion of Street</u></b>
<u>15.</u>	Point Road (L52007)	From a point 80m north east of the junction of main street with the pedestrian Pier entrance extending north eastward for a distance of 24m, for a width of 9m.
<u>16</u>	Main Street (L52007)	From a point 147m west of the junction of main street with the the pedestrian Pier entrance extending south westward for a distance of 10.6m , for a maximum width of 14m
<u>17</u>	Point Road (L52007)	From of the junction of the point road with the pedestrian Pier entrance extending north eastward for a distance of 30m, for a maximum width of 3m.
<u>18</u>	Point Road (L52007)	From a point 37m north east of the junction of the point road with the pedestrian Pier entrance extending north eastward for a distance of 23m, for a maximum width of 2.2m.

## SUMMARY

With the development of the new harbour at Cill Rónáin and the provision of approx 121 car parking spaces, 32 tour bus spaces, 3 disabled parking spaces, and space for 20 Jarveys. It is hoped that this will eliminate the requirement for on street parking. The implementations of these parking proposals are essential for the future growth and prosperity of Cill Rónáin.

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
