TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS

ROADS ACT 1993 – SECTION 75 ROADS REGULATIONS 1994 – ARTICLE 12

NOTICES OF INTENTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council proposes to make an order closing the L-3201 from its junction with the R-350 Bullaun to Loughrea Regional Road in Bullaun Village to its junction with the L-7205 Ballykeeran to Raford Local Secondary Road at Ballykeeran Bridge from 8.00am on Monday 23rd August, 2010 to 5.00pm on Friday 24th September, 2010 to facilitate the reconstruction of the L-3201 local primary route.

Alternative Route

Traffic travelling on the R-350 Loughrea to Bullaun Road will be diverted onto the L-7203 Larchill Road at Lackalea. From here traffic will continue to the junction with the N-65 Link road (i.e. linking the M6 Motorway with Loughrea). From here traffic will turn right and head north to its junction with the L-7204 Ballykeeran Road. Here traffic will turn right and will continue to its junction with the L-3201. This will be the end of the diversion.

Traffic travelling from L-7182 Kiltullagh direction will divert onto the L-7204 Ballykeeran Road. They will continue along this road until the junction with the N-65 Link Road (i.e. linking the M6 Motorway with Loughrea). From here traffic will turn left and continue to its junction with the L-7203 Larchill Road. Here traffic will turn left and continue to its junction with the R-350 Loughrea to Bullaun Road. From here traffic can head north to Bullaun Village. This is the end of the diversion.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council proposes to make an order closing the R-351 Loughrea to Woodford Regional Road from its junction with the Cross Street/Barrack Street junction in Loughrea town to its junction with the L-4215 Aille to Killeenadeema Local Primary Road at Aille Cross and also the L-4214 Earlsparck Road from its junction with the R-351 Loughrea to Woodford Regional Road to its junction with the L-4215 at Killeenadeema Cross from 10.00am on Sunday 12th September, 2010 to 4.00pm on Sunday 12th September, 2010 to facilitate the running of triathlon events.

Alternative Route

Traffic travelling on the R-351 from the Woodford direction towards Loughrea will travel as far as Aille cross to the junction with the L-4215 Aille to Killeenadeema Local Primary Road upon which traffic will be diverted. The diverted traffic will continue along the L-4215 and then the L-4216 Killeenadeema to Curheen Road until its junction with the N-66 Loughrea to Gort National Secondary Road. At this junction traffic will turn right and will enter Loughrea town. Traffic will then turn right onto the L-4227 Courthouse Road and then onto the L-4228 Barrack Street Road. Traffic will continue to the end of Barrack Street. This will be the end of the diversion route.

Traffic travelling from Loughrea wishing to access the R-351 Loughrea to Woodford Road will be diverted onto the L-4213 Cross Street towards Masonbrook and then turn right onto the L-8224 Aille to Glennaslat Road at Glennaslat. Traffic will continue to the end of this road until its junction with the R-351. This will be the end of the diversion route.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council proposes to make an order closing the R-351 Loughrea to Woodford Regional Road from its junction with the Cross Street/Barrack Street junction in Loughrea town to its junction with the L-4215 Aille to Killeenadeema Local Primary Road at Aille Cross from 8.00am on Tuesday 14th September, 2010 to 5.00pm on Thursday 30th September, 2010 to facilitate the installation of a new box culvert on the R-351 so as to alleviate flooding of the area.

Alternative Route

Traffic travelling on the R-351 from the Woodford direction towards Loughrea will travel as far as Aille cross to the junction with the L-4215 Aille to Killeenadeema Local Primary Road upon which traffic will be diverted. The diverted traffic will continue along the L-4215 and then the L-4216 Killeenadeema to Curheen Road until its junction with the N-66 Loughrea to Gort National Secondary Road. At this junction traffic will turn right and will enter Loughrea town. Traffic will then turn right onto the L-4227 Courthouse Road and then onto the L-4228 Barrack Street Road. Traffic will continue to the end of Barrack Street. This will be the end of the diversion route.

Traffic travelling from Loughrea wishing to access the R-351 Loughrea to Woodford Road will be diverted onto the N-66 Loughrea to Gort National Secondary Road until its junction with the L-4216 Curheen to Killeenadeema Local Primary Road. Here diverted traffic will turn left and continue along the L-4216 and then the L-4215 Killeenadeema to Aille Local Primary Road. Traffic will continue to the end of the L-4215 until its junction with the R-351 at Aille Cross. This is the end of the diversion route.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council proposes to make an order closing a section of Road No. L-5221 southward from its junction with the R374 for a distance of 2500m to its junction with the L-1202 in the townlands of Carrowroe West and Carrowroe North from 8.30am Monday 23rd August, 2010 to 5.00pm Friday 27th August, 2010 for the purposes of a culvert replacement at Tooreengrave.

Alternative Route

The alternative route is via R374 eastward from its junction with the L-5221 for a distance of 1200m to its junction with the L-1201 continuing southward for a distance of 1800m to its junction with the L-5221 in the townlands of Carrowroe West and Carrowroe North.

NOTICE OF INTENTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council proposes to make an order closing the following road for the purpose as stated hereunder:

BURKE'S LANE, ATHENRY

Burke's Lane, Athenry from its junction with Northgate Street to its junction with Market Square, Athenry from 8.00 am on Wednesday, 22nd September 2010 to 6.00 pm on Wednesday 22nd September 2010 to facilitate events to mark European Mobility Week and '*In Town Without My Car*'.

Alternative Route:

Traffic on Northgate Street will continue along this street in a North Easterly direction until The Arch. From here traffic will turn right onto Court Lane & will continue until its junction with Bridge Street. From here traffic will turn right & continue to Market Square. This will be the end of the diversion.

Traffic can also access Market Square from Old Church Street by travelling along Davis Street instead of entering the one way street of Northgate Street. Heavy Goods Vehicles will also need to follow this line of travel as they will not be able to travel under the Arch on Northgate Street.

Pedestrian/Cyclist Access shall be maintained at all times.
