## Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe Galway County Council



### Réamhrá

Tá cead speisialta ag teastáil chun feithicil a úsáid a sháraíonn uasmheáchán agus toisí uasta atá leagtha amach do feithicil agus leantóirí inneallghluaiste ar bhóthar poiblí.

Féadfaidh údarás áitiúil de réir Alt 13 den Acht um Thrácht ar Bhóithre 1961 agus na Rialacháin um Thrácht ar Bhóithre (Déanamh agus Úsáid Feithicilí) 1963 - 2003 cead speisialta a eisiúint ag ceadú do feithicil ar leith a sháraíonn uasmheáchán agus toisí uasta feithicil agus leantóirí inneallghluaiste a bheith in úsáid ar bhóithre poiblí.

Is cion atá ann faoi Alt 12 / 13 den Acht um Thrácht ar Bhóithre, 1961 na Rialacháin um Thrácht ar Bhóithre (Déanamh agus Úsáid Feithicilí) 1963 - 2003 a shárú ach amháin de réir cead speisialta a bheith eisithe i leith an feithicil (lí).

### Foirm iarratais a chomhlánú

Ba chóir an fhoirm iarratais a chomhlánú go soiléir agus é a bheith soléite – déanfar foirmeacha neamhiomlán nó doléite a chur ar ais.

### Introduction

A special permit is required in order to use a vehicle which contravenes the maximum weight and dimensions set for mechanically propelled vehicles and trailers on a public road.

A local authority may in accordance with section 13 of the Road Traffic Act 1961 and the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Vehicles) Regulations 1963 – 2003 issue a special permit authorising particular vehicles which contravene the maximum weight and dimensions of mechanically propelled vehicles and trailers to be used on public roads.

It is an offence under section 12 / 13 of the Road Traffic Act, 1961 to contravene the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Vehicles) Regulations 1963 – 2003 except in accordance with a special permit issued in respect of the vehicle/(s).

### Completing the application form

The application form should be completed clearly and legibly – incomplete or illegible forms shall be returned.

Ba chóir an fhoirm iarratais agus é comhlánaithe go hiomlán a sheoladh ar ais chuig An tAonad Bóithre & Iompair (féach an seoladh thíos).

### **Táille**

Chun cead speisialta a eisiúint tá táille €100 i gceist.

### **Fógra roimhe seo**

Roimh iarratas a dhéanamh ar chead speisialta, tabharfaidh an iarrthóir fógra ceithre lá oibre glan do Choimisinéir na Garda Síochána don chineál sin iarratas. Beidh cóip den iarratas don chead iniata leis an bhfógra.

### **Gealltanais**

Beidh gealltanais san iarratas ag an iarrthóir chun aon damáiste a dhéantar do bhóithre poiblí de bharr úsáid na feithicil (lí) faoin gcead a aisíoc le Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe.

Chun na críche seo, féadfaidh Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe mar choinníoll don chead iarrfaidh ar an iarrthóir suim airgid a chur i dtaisce leis an gComhairle chun an damáiste a chlúdú, nó chun dóthain urrús a aimsiú.

The fully completed application form should be returned to The Roads & Transportation Unit (see address below).

### **Fee**

There is currently a fee of €100 for the issue of a special permit.

### **Prior notice**

Prior to making an application for a special permit, the applicant shall give the Commissioner of the Garda Síochána four clear working days notice of such application. The notice shall be accompanied by a copy of the application for the permit.

### **Undertaking**

An application for a permit shall contain an undertaking by the applicant to refund to Galway County Council the amount of any damage caused to any public road by the use of the vehicle(s) under the permit.

Galway County Council may for this purpose require the applicant as a condition of the permit either to deposit with the Council a sum sufficient to cover the amount of such damage, or to furnish other sufficient security.

## Cead

Beidh cead sa feithicil lena mbaineann sé i gcónaí, nó ar an bhfeithicil atá ag tarraingt an leantóir lena mbaineann sé.

Beidh cead bailí ar feadh tréimhse 3 mhí ar an mhéid ón dáta a eisíodh é, nó ar feadh tréimhse níos lú de réir mar atá sé sonraithe.

### Cead a Tharraingt siar:

Féadfaidh Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe cead a tharraingt siar do feithicil lena bhfuil cead eisithe in úsáid faoi shárú aon choinníoll a bhaineann don chead.

Má bhíonn Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe chun cead a tharraingt siar tabharfar fógra 21 lá go bhfuil sé ar intinn sin a dhéanamh agus déanfar breithniú ar aon uiríll a dhéanann an sealbhóir laistigh den tréimhse sin.

## Permit

A permit shall at all times be carried on the vehicle to which it relates, or on the vehicle drawing the trailer to which it relates.

A permit shall be valid for a maximum of 3 months from the date of issue, or for such period as may be stated in it.

### Withdrawal of permit

Where a vehicle in respect of which a permit has been issued, is being used in contravention of any condition attached to the permit, Galway County Council may withdraw the permit.

Where Galway County Council proposes to withdraw a permit it shall give 21 day's notice of such intention and shall consider any representations made by the holder within that period.
