TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS

Roads Act 1993 – Section 75

Roads Regulations 1994 – Article 12

Notice of Intention

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council proposes to make an order closing the L-7182 Bookeen South-Carrowkeel local secondary road from its junction with the L-3114 Kiltullagh-Carrabane local primary road at Bookeen South to its junction with the N65 National Secondary Link Road (next to the interchange at the new M6 motorway) at Carrowkeel from 8am on Monday 21st June 2010 to 4pm on Friday 23rd July 2010 in order to facilitate road reconstruction of the L-7182.

Alternative Route

Traffic travelling along the N-65 at Carrowkeel & wishing to access the L-7182 Carrowkeel-Bookeen South road will continue along the N-65 Southwards until its junction with the L-7204 Tooloobaunbeg-Tooloobauntemple local secondary road at Tooloobauntemple Townland. Here traffic will exit the N-65 onto the L-7204 & continue Westwards to its junction with the L-3114 Carrabane-Killtullagh local primary road at Bookeen South. From here traffic will turn right onto the L-3114 & continue Northwards until its junction with the L-7182 Bookeen South-Carrowkeel local secondary road at Bookeen South. This is the end of the diversion.

Traffic travelling along the L-3114 Carrabane-Kiltullagh local primary road & wishing to access the L-7182 at Bookeen South will continue onto the L-7204 Tooloobaunbeg-Tooloobauntemple local secondary road. From here traffic will exit the L-3114 onto the L-7204 & travel eastwards until its junction with the N-65 at Carrowkeel. At this junction traffic will turn left & continue Northwards to its junction with the L-7182 Carrowkeel-Bookeen South local secondary road at Carrowkeel. This is the end of the diversion.

Alternative Route for Regional & HGV Traffic

Traffic travelling from the M6 motorway from both the Ballinasloe & Galway directions will be diverted onto the L-7182 Killtullagh-Killarriv local secondary road once they exit the motorway at the Carrowkeel motorway interchange. From here traffic will continue into Killtullagh village to the junction with the L-3114 Kiltullagh-Carrabane road. Traffic will then continue southwards to the junction with the L-7182 at Bookeen South. This is the end of the diversion.

Local access will be maintained.

Objections to the proposed temporary closure may be submitted in writing to the **Director of Services, Roads & Transportation Unit, Galway County Council, Áras an Chontae, Prospect Hill, Galway** not later than **12.00 p.m. on Friday, 4th June, 2010.**
