**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS
Roads Act 1993 – Section 75
Roads Regulations 1994 – Article 12
Notice of Decision**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council has made an order closing subject to conditions the L-7182 Killtullagh-Killarriv road from its junction with the L-3114 Kiltullagh-Carrabane road at Kiltullagh village (beside the soccer pitch) to its junction with the L-7183 Clashaganny road at Clashaganny (beside M6 Motorway interchange) from 8a.m. on Monday 29th March, 2010 to 7p.m. on Monday 19th April, 2010, to facilitate road reconstruction of the L-7182.

Alternative Route

Traffic travelling from Athenry along the R-348 and from Carnakelly/Attymon on the L-3115 wishing to access the L-7182 at Kiltullagh will continue along the R-348 eastwards until its junction with the L-7184 (“The Hidden Drive” road) at Raford village. Traffic will then turn right and continue south to its junction with the L-7183 Clashaganny road. From here traffic will turn right onto the L-7183 Clashaganny road and continue south west until the L-7182. This is the end of the diversion.

Traffic travelling from Bullaun along the L-3201 and from the new M6 motorway wishing to access the L-7182 at Killarriv/Clashaganny will be diverted onto the L-7183 Clashaganny road. From here traffic will travel north east until its junction with the L-7184 (“The Hidden Drive” road). At this junction traffic will turn left and continue north to its junction with the R-348 Raford-Kiltullagh regional road. At the R-348 junction traffic will turn left and continue westwards into Killtullagh village. This is the end of the diversion.
