Tugtar fógra leis seo go bhfuil sé i gceist ag Comhairle Chontae na Gaillimhe cead a lorg ón gCoimisiún Pleanála faoi Alt 177AE den Acht um Pleanáil agus Forbairt, 2000 (arna leasú) chun forbairt bheartaithe a dhéanamh in aice leis an N59 in Uachtar Ard, Co. na Gaillimhe sna bailte fearainn Ceann Ramhar Thiar, An Chreig, An Cheathrú Mheánach, An Fhuathach Thiar, Uachtar Ard, Contae na Gaillimhe. Is éard a bheidh i gceist leis an bhforbairt bheartaithe droichead nua coisithe téad bogha cruach íseal a thógáil thar Abhainn Ruibhe, thart ar 150m síos an abhainn (ó dheas) ó dhroichead bóthair an N59 atá ann cheana in Uachtar Ard, Co. na Gaillimhe. Beidh an droichead coise atá beartaithe suas go dtí thart ar 3.6m ar airde, agus thart ar 48.23m ar fhad, le leithead deice glan 3m. Beidh mar chuid den fhorbairt atá beartaithe freisin síneadh a chur le gach taobh d'Abhainn Ruibhe (níl aon oibreacha srutha beartaithe); tá sé beartaithe rampa rochtana 3m ar leithead glan a cheangal leis an gcosán cois abhainn atá ann cheana agus le Bóthar na Ceathrún Meánach siar ó thuaidh (tá sé beartaithe freisin rochtain chéimnithe ar an gcosán a cheangal leis an N59 soir ó dheas, agus crosaire coisithe nua le tábla luais agus líne colbha carrbhealaigh athailínithe ag gach ceann acu; an balla teorann atá ann a scartáil agus a atógáil/a athailíniú leis an áitreabh atá ann cheana ó thuaidh agus leis an áitreabh atá ann cheana ó dheas ar a dtugtar an tSeabhheairic; agus gach obair choimhdeach lena n-áirítear ballaí, fálú, ráilí coisithe, mullaird, comharthalocht, soilsiú, binsí, tírdhreachú crua agus bog, lena n-áirítear crainn chúiteacha a chur i bPáirc na Ceathrún Meánach, agus an príomhphíobán uisce agus séarach comhcheangailte atá ann cheana a atreorú/a athsholáthar.

NOTICE OF PLANNING APPLICATION TO
AN COIMISIÚN PLEANÁLA FOR APPROVAL

Notice is hereby given that Galway County Council intends to seek the approval of An Coimisiún Pleanála under Section 177AE of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended) to carry out a proposed development adjacent to the N59 in Oughterard, Co. Galway in the townlands of Canrawer West, Cregg, Carrowmanagh, Fough West, Oughterard, County Galway. The proposed development will consist of the construction of a new low steel bow string truss pedestrian footbridge over the Owenriff River, approximately 150m downstream (east) of the existing N59 road bridge, Oughterard, Co. Galway. The proposed footbridge will be up to approximately 3.6m in height, and approximately 48.23m in length, with a 3m clear deck width. The proposed development will also consist of an abutment to either side of the Owenriff River (no instream works are proposed); a 3m clear width access ramp is proposed to tie in to the existing riverside walkway and Carrowmanagh Road to the north-west (stepped access to the walkway is also proposed) and to tie into the N59 to the south-east, each with a new pedestrian crossing with speed table and realigned carriageway kerb line; the demolition and rebuilding/realignment of the existing boundary wall to the existing dwelling to the north and to the existing dwelling to the south known as The Old Barracks; and all ancillary works including walls, fencing, pedestrian railings, bollards, signage, lighting, benches, hard and soft landscaping, including compensatory tree planting at Carrowmanagh Park, and the diversion/replacement of an existing watermain and combined sewer.

A Natura Impact Statement has been prepared as part of the application for approval in respect of the proposed development.

An Coimisiún Pleanála may give approval to the application for development with or without conditions or may refuse the application for development.

Any submissions/observations must be received by An Coimisiún Pleanála no later than 5:30pm on 1st September 2025.

A person may question the validity of any such decision by An Coimisiún Pleanála by way of an application for judicial review under Order B4 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986) in accordance with Section 50 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended).
