

Galway County Council proposes the following Traffic Management Measure for Athenry:

To make the LS7124, New Line Road, <u>one-way only</u> from its junction with the Bridge Court estate to its junction with the LP-3107 Monivea Road (a distance of 245m). Traffic shall be permitted to travel <u>northwards only</u> along this section. Traffic from the Monivea Road shall be prohibited from turning right on to the New Line Road. Traffic seeking to travel from the Monivea Road to the New Line Road or towards Tuam must continue to the next junction at Gairmscoil Mhuire (the Vocational School) on the Caheroyn Road and make a right turn at that location.
