Pilot Streetscape Enhancement Scheme (Athenry & Ballinasloe)

Galway County Council is pleased to announce the Pilot Streetscape Enhancement Scheme for 2020. The objective of the scheme is to improve the visual appearance of urban streetscapes, sustain existing and attract new footfall and support a reduction in commercial vacancies within town centres. This in turn will support our towns reputation as an attractive place to live, work and invest in.

- 1. Tenants or owners of buildings (residential and non-residential) can avail of a grant towards the cost of painting and improving facades along the street which may include paint, labour, scaffold/ hoist and other materials etc. Priority will be given to full façade applications i.e. shop fronts/ground floor and overhead. Quotations from competent contractors detailing the works to be carried out including colour(s), finishes etc will be required.
- 2. Tenants or owners of buildings can avail of a grant towards the cost of replacing existing plastic, neon & printed signs etc. The improvement of existing window displays, installation of awnings and the purchase of street furniture may also be considered under this category. Tenants or owners of buildings may also apply for masonry repair or other repair and improvement works as set out below. Details of all proposed works must be submitted.
- 3. Applications are currently being considered within the town centre boundaries as marked on the enclosed "scheme boundary" map.
- 4. Applications on a full street basis or for 5 or more adjacent buildings on one street, will be prioritised over individual applications. Tenants and property owners are encouraged to work together in order to bring forward proposals that will provide a significant visual impact.

Max Grant (50% of cost, up to maximum amount listed below)

Green enhancement of entrances/ terraces with planting	€500
Painting of building/shopfront in carefully selected colours which will complement the host building and streetscape.	€1,000
Decluttering and repair of shopfronts. (decluttering can include such works as removing unnecessary signs, flagpoles, wiring etc.)	
Careful illumination and lighting of architectural features of buildings.	
Improvements to shopfront window displays and staging.	
Replacement of signage with traditional wooden fascia with wooden/hand painted lettering OR contemporary design using a range of approved materials.	€2,000
Canopies/Awnings complementary to the	
materials of the shopfront and building (including street furniture). (Applicants are advised to note licensing/planning requirements may apply to certain street furniture)	
Replacement of existing shopfront with traditional painted wooden shopfront OR contemporary design using a range of materials approved by GCC.	€4,000

The following steps need to be taken to qualify for the Grant:

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
Make a formal application in writing to Regeneration Department, Economic, Rural & Community Development Section, Galway County Council, Áras an Chontae, Prospect Hill, Galway H91 H6KX or regeneration@galwaycoco.ie providing the following information:

- Completed application form.
- Good quality photographs of the building's present condition/current signage arrangement.
- Include quotations as applicable with details of work and cost breakdown (see No. 1& 2 above)
- Details of the proposed new signage. The proposed signs should be submitted for approval by GCC and be of wood or wood/cast metal construction and painted. Plastic, sheet metal, neon etc. will not be considered unless in exceptional circumstances. One quotation from the sign manufacturer will be required. As appropriate Galway County Council may refer signage proposals to the Heritage/Conservation Officer for comment/sanction.
- Where works are undertaken without the prior written approval of GCC, a grant will not be awarded to the applicant, the grant must be approved in advance. On completion of works, the Council are to be notified and photographs should be submitted, an inspection may be arranged. Works must be completed within 4 months of the date of approval.
- Please note if works are not complete within the timeframe, the grant will lapse unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Council.
- Professional design fees associated with individual projects/applications are not an eligible cost under the scheme.
- If the scheme is oversubscribed the applicants eligible to continue in the application process will be selected by what is considered by Galway County Council to deliver the greatest impact in terms of visual appearance and streetscape enhancement.
- Where a contractor is appointed it shall be the responsibility of the successful applicants to ensure that all necessary consents are obtained and all relevant legislation and codes of practice, in particular those related to Health & Safety and Planning which apply to such work and / or approved schemes, are complied with.
- It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all relevant legislation including planning laws are adhered to during the works.
- Payment of the grant will be made once paid invoices have been submitted and the works have been confirmed as complete.
- Photographs of approved properties may be used in future promotions of the Streetscape Enhancement Scheme.

The Council reserves the right not to fund proposals which it considers inappropriate.

The palette of materials has been restricted for this scheme so as to maintain a level of variation in colors throughout the street.
