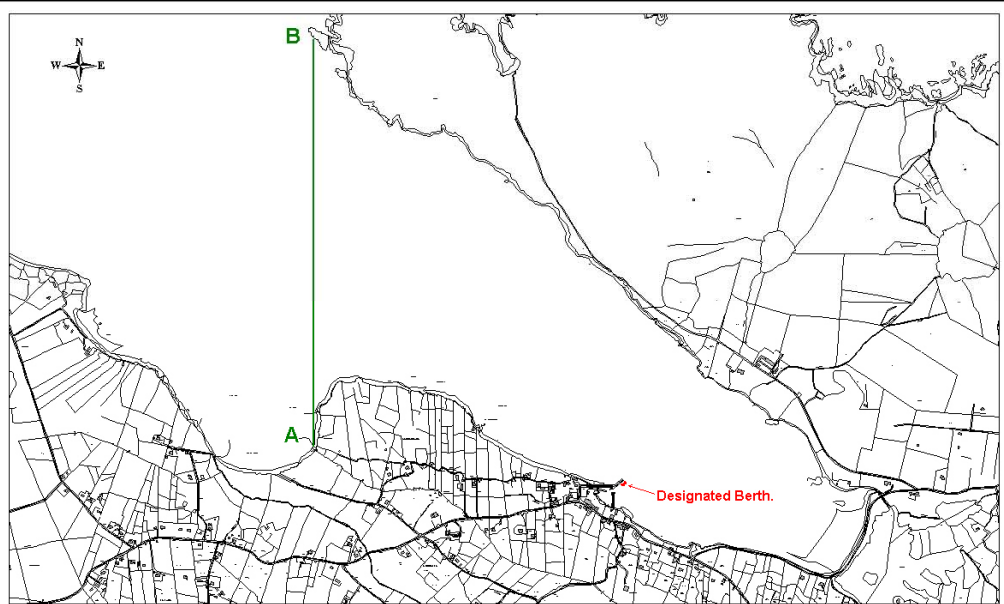


Extract from Admiralty Chart 1820 Scale 1:50,000

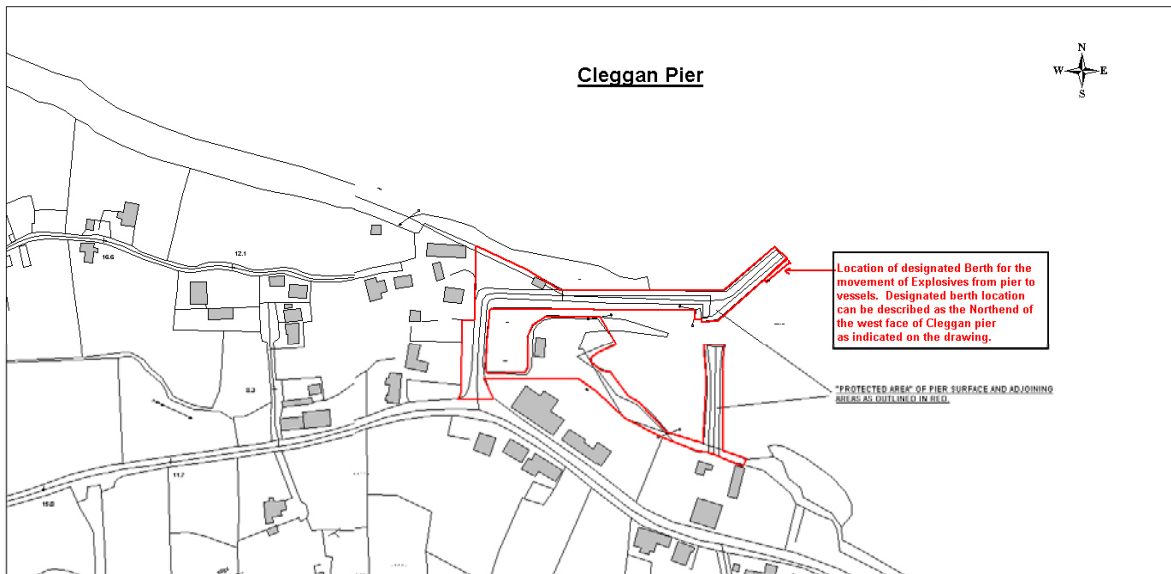
