The following items are accepted FREE OF CHARGE from the DOMESTIC sector

1. **Green, clear, and brown glass** i.e. bottles and Jars
2. **Plastic items** - Household plastic items including soft drinks bottles, plastic water bottles, 2 litre milk containers, yogurt pots, butter and margarine tubs etc. (**it is important to note that each plastic item must be washed and clean**)
3. **Cardboard and Newspaper (Baled or tied)**
4. **Beverage cans**
5. **Flat Glass** i.e. window glass, windscreens and mirrors.
(It is important to note that this service is for flat glass only and under no circumstances will window frames or doors be accepted at the Recycling Centre i.e. all glass must be removed from frames.)
6. **Electrical and Electronic Equipment** - All Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) such as fridges, freezers, fridge/freezers, electrical cookers, microwaves, televisions, computers, DVD players, radios, electric heaters, hoovers, toasters, grills etc. (as it is impossible to give an exhaustive list of what will be accepted a good guideline is that if it has an electrical plug or electronics in its composition it will be accepted. If in further doubt please ring the recycling centre, ask at the site, or contact the Environment Section, Galway County Council at 091-509302)
7. **Battery operated items** -All battery operated items such as children's toys, remotes, torches, cameras, games, etc. (as it is impossible to give an exhaustive list of what will be accepted a good guideline is that if it uses a battery in its operation or use it will be accepted. If in further doubt please ring the recycling centre, ask at the site, or contact the Environment Section, Galway County Council at 091-509302)
8. **Batteries** - car batteries, household batteries, mobile phone batteries, button batteries, rechargeable batteries, etc.
9. **Light Bulbs** - long life CFL and Fluorescent tubes **only** (ordinary bayonet bulbs will not be accepted)
10. **Waste oil and oil filters**- engine oil only
11. **Household Hazardous Waste** which is fully labelled and readily identifiable will be accepted including pesticides, herbicides, aerosols, paint thinners and old medicine. Paint, paint cans, [paint](#) brushes, [paint](#) rollers etc will also be accepted.
12. **Mobile phones**
13. **Toner Cartridges**- including inkjet, laser and fax cartridges.
14. **Clothes**- all clothes, paired shoes, towels, sheets, blankets, curtains, handbags and belts in good condition.

15. **Scrap Metal** - all scrap metal objects such as bicycles, lawnmowers, metal fencing, metal sheeting, pots, pans, metal offcuts etc. (any large object should be broken up so as they can be handled safely).

IMPORTANT NOTICE

The following conditions apply to the use of Ballinasloe Recycling Centre by the public

- Services and operating times are subject to change
- The services provided are for the domestic sector only
- Household Hazardous Waste that is not fully labeled or readily identifiable will not be accepted
- Household textiles must be in good condition
- Window frames or doors are not accepted with flat glass
- Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) will be accepted from the **retail** sector by prior arrangement, and with proof of registration under the Waste Management (Waste Electrical and Electronic Regulations) 2005.
