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INTRODUCTION

The N63 which passes through the town of Mountbellew is the main traffic artery linking Galway city to the north east of the county. The R358 is also an important route linking the north of county Galway to the east of the county. As a result of the large volume of local and passing traffic it is essential that a Traffic Management Plan be in place & implemented effectively to allow the efficient movement of traffic through the town.

The Mountbellew Traffic Management Plan was first implemented in 1997, and provided for parking restrictions at Pinegrove Housing Estate, Mountbellew Bridge and the Square.

The revised restrictions listed attached allows for continuation of the existing restrictions mentioned above and also for additional parking restrictions on the R358.

Objectives of this plan:

The broad objectives of the MountbellewTraffic Management Plan are:

- Removal of congestion.
- Efficient Traffic Flow
- Improve Safety.

4	R358 Holy Rosary College	Continuous Double Yellow Line.	A) From a point 146 m east of R358 junction at square extending 18.5 m along north side of R358. B) From a point 174 m east of R358 junction at square extending 15 m along north side of R358. C) From a point 235 m west of R358/L3210 junction extending 5 m along the north side of the R358.
5	R358	Continuous Double Yellow Line.	From a point 227 m south east of R358 junction at square extending 5.5 m along south side of R358.
