Compost is also a natural way of providing plants with the nutrients it needs rather than using chemical fertilizers. Composting also helps to conserve natural habitats for future generations.

STURDY RECYCONE

As the heat from the sun speeds up the process you will find that during the winter your RECYCONE slows down a little, but don't worry, it has been designed to cope with the amount of waste from a busy family home. In the summer months you can help the RECYCONE by removing the compost from the base using the opening provided. The opening is normally covered by the bottom hatch, this is opened to expose the access hopening. By removing the compost you allow the new material above to drop down, aerating the RECYCONE and helping it to work. This should only need to be done twice a year, even for the busiest RECYCONE.

WHERE DOES COMPOSTING FIT INTO RECYCLING

The chart on this page illustrates the make up of an average Irish dustbin. Many of the sections shown are familiar recyclable items and recycling containers for them are common, but the largest section in this section is kitchen waste and this is the area your RECYCONE can help with. By using the RECYCONE the Local Authority will have to collect less waste from your area, reducing costs to provide the service, needing fewer rubbish tips and helping to reduce the damage to the atmosphere.

YOUR STURDY RECYCONE AND THE WORLD

The benefits of using your RECYCONE does not stop at home. Though you will soon find that the compost is useful and that your dustbin no longer has that familiar "dustbin pong" the biggest benefits will be felt by you outside the house.
