Application to An Bord Pleanála

Galway County Council hereby gives notice in accordance with Section 177AE of the above Act, as inserted by Section 57 of the Planning & Development (amendment) Act 2010, that it proposes to seek approval of An Bord Pleanála to carry out development at this site in the townland of Kinincha, Gort,

The proposed development is a Civic Amenity Site / Recycling Center for mixed household municipal waste streams and will comprise the following elements ; a mobile pay station office / welfare unit, car parking, internal concrete paved roads and lay down areas, surface water collection system, service connections, transportable waste skips, mobile bunded containers, public lighting and landscaping works.

Galway County Council has prepared a Natura Impact Statement (NIS) in respect of the proposed development. This NIS, along with plans and particulars of the proposed development, are available for inspection or purchase, at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, in the offices of Galway County Council, Aras an Chontae, Prospect Hill, Galway during normal office hours from Thursday 13th May, 2021 until Thursday 24th June, 2021.

Submissions and observations in respect of the proposed development relating to:

- The implications of the proposed development for proper planning and sustainable development in the area concerned
- The likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, and
- The likely significant effects of the proposed development on a European site, if carried out

may be made in writing, without charge, to An Bord Pleanála, Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, no later than 5.30pm on Thursday 24th June, 2021.

An Bord Pleanála may give approval to the application for development with or without conditions or may refuse the application for the development.
