Joe Loughnane

Joe Loughnane is involved with the Connaught Rangers Association since 2002. He is active in promoting the Connaught Rangers within the Galway area, and their connections with the West of Ireland. He is also involved with the Loughrea Memorial project.

Willie Henry

Willie Henry is an archaeologist, local historian and author from Galway City. To date he has written nine historical books, twelve booklets and numerous articles. His two latest books *Galway and the Great War 1914-1918* and *Forgotten Heroes Galway Soldiers of the Great War 1914-1918*, the latter with the full listings of the 1,100 men from County Galway who perished.

Oliver Fallon

Oliver Fallon is General Secretary and one of the founder members of the Connaught Rangers Association. His lecture is titled *'The German offensive March 21st 1918 and the Implications for the Connaught Rangers.'*

Damian Quinn

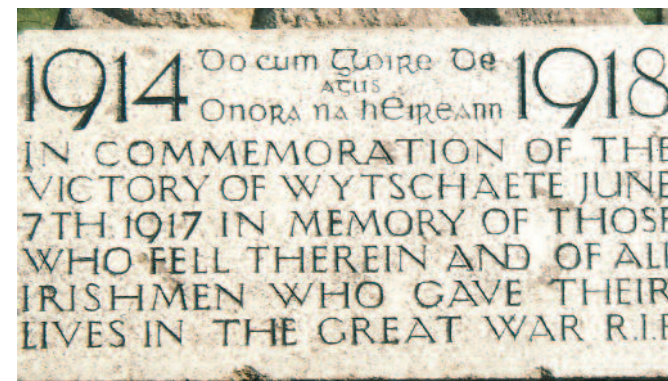
