(No. 1) Rural District Council, held at the Board Room, Union Workhouse,
on Saturday the 9th day of November 1907.

The Minutes of last Meeting were read and signed.

The Clerk reported that there was a vacancy on the Council owing to the death of Mr James H. Parre which occurred on the 26th ultimo.

Read a letter from Mr Hayden, the Council's Solicitor stating that the Records at the recent Ballinasloe Quarter Sessions granted Part Dolan £10 compensation for Hay to be levied off the divisions of Aughorm & Oatfield: and endorsing Bill of Costs £1.10.0 in relation to same

Mr Ryan proposed and Mr McEvoy seconded and Resolved "That we beg to tender to the Brothers and friends of the late Mr Parre, who was a member of this Council since its first existence, our sincere sympathy in their bereavement."

Mr Dolan proposed and Mr McGrath seconded and Resolved "That this Council condemn in the strongest way turning of hay, and all outrages as it is a big drain on the poor-rate payers compensating parties for such outrages"

It was Resolved that the office of Rural District Council be held by Mr Michael Larkin for Kilmacshann E.D. be deemed vacant owing to the Larkin's absence through illness. The Declaration of vacancy was signed by the Chairman and Messrs R. W. Finney and James McEvoy -

The Council decided to fill the vacancy on the 27th Dec next.
