Mr Chairman and Gentlemen,

The roads in the District show no signes of improvement during the The want of a proper application of metal during past quarter. the Winter is now apparent on most roads, and the fow gravel repairs executed by contractors during the last three months are altogether insufficient to keep the roads in enything like proper repair. Prainage too, has been either carelessly attended to, or entirely neglected. The importance of this branch of road maintenance has often been impressed upon contractors, but still gullets are choked, outlets, back and side rains are not cleared, and water tables in most cases non-existent. The effect of this is to provent the surface water from getting off the road, and the road scarcely ever gets a chance of drying until the body of the road get rotten.

EN STATE OF THE ST

The attention of contractors has also been frequently drawn to the macessity for having hedges cut to proper heights and branches lopped. The statutory time for compelling owners and occupiors to have this work done has now elapsed, and very few contractors have availed themselves of the power given them by law to have this important work done. The numbered of shrubs and briars growing on the sides of public roads is too common to mention more than to warn contractors that all such must be removed during the coming season. Copings of protection walls and parapets are almost entirely neglected, and contractors do not seem to realize that this forms part of their maintenance work, and is specifically provided for in their specifications. For the coming season, it will be necessary owing to the starved condition of the roads to appead metal. This must be done with care, and care should be taken to blind all such metal with good clean gravel, not soul.

It would be well if your Council would send a resolution to the County Council to lay say two-thirds of the yearly money in Winter.

The presents system of road work is producing bad results. This matter has already been brought before you.

Relative to works in progress:— The new road at Clonfert. No progress has been made with this work. Owing to difficulty in getting material this work has been stopped. The bonds have been renewed and sout to the County Council, and I have written to Mr Seymour for same to institute fruch proceedings. Puring the past wet weather the contractor would find great difficulty in obtaining material, but he had ample opportunity for going on with fence work and other details. The second bridge should have been completed before now. I have frequently spoken to the contractor to have this work done, but without at avail. In regard to the new road at Panning's Lock, some progress has been made but not sufficient to justify a payment. This work is going on too slowly. The fencing and other works that might have been pushed forward during the wet weather has been neglected. If a more seriour attempt he not made to carry out this contract, I will be obliged to take this road up unfor the 54th Section, and expend the available money directly.


