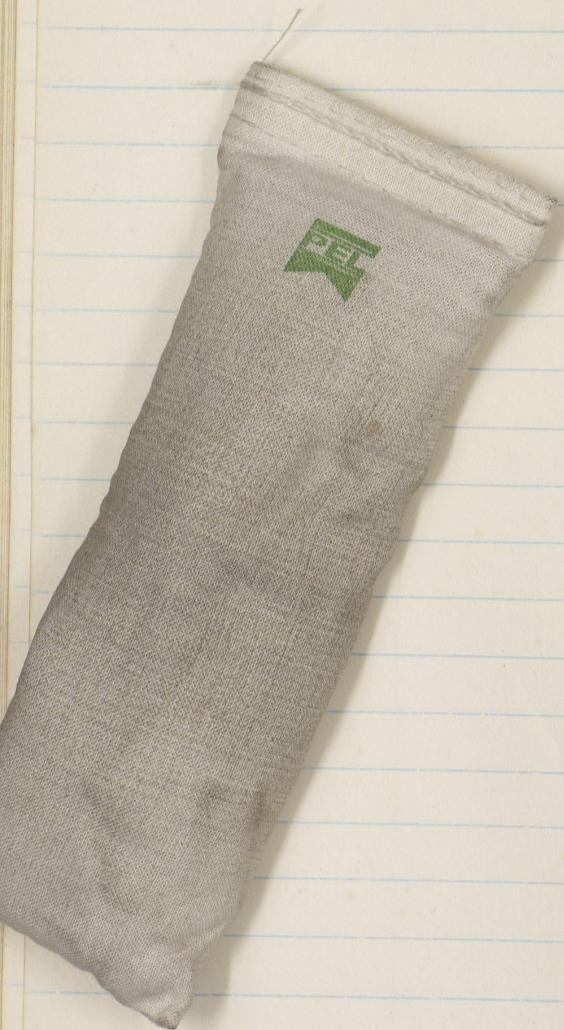

The Chairman having put Mr. Loughmane's amendment by a show of hands declared it lost, when it was Ordered/- "That the seat be declared vacant Co-option to take place on the 26th. February 1916." and that the Clerk duly advertise same. ✓

The Clerk read a lengthy Memorial from the Inhabitants living in the Village of Newcastle asking the Council to have the Newcastle Old Road made to meet the other end, now under contract, and stating that the Congested Districts Board are giving half the cost. ✓
