Letter from the Local Government Board No. 64,825/1915 dated

17th. December, 1915 informing the Guardians that they have received
the report of their Inspector Mr. Pack-Beresford on the Inquiry
held by him with regard to the recent election of an Assistant
Olerk.

Having fully considered the evidence, the Local Government Board have come to the conclusion that the Mection which too place on the 18th. September last, the return of the poll as recorded on the Minutes was correct, and in these circumstances the election of Mr. M. D. O'Carroll appears to have been properly made, so far as the office of Assistant Clerk of the Union is concerned.

As regards, however the offices of Assistant Clerk of the No. 1 & 2 Rural District Councils, the Board have to state that there does not appear to have been any legal authority for the mode of procedure adopted, and it will be necessary that the election for these posts should be taken de novo.
