Mr Lyons moved his motion " To repair about 320 perches of the old road leading from the public road at Scott's forge to Michael Lyons' house at Kellysgrove".

The work was unanimously passed, and the 4th August was fixed for the adjourned quarterly meeting to receive tenders.

After the reading of the recommendations for payment, on the suggestion of Mr. John Whyns, it was agreed to ask the County Council to reconsider the large amount of money struck off on John Burns having regard to the amount of work done by him now at the expiration of his contract.

The Provisional proposal of Mr. McDermott, "That a loan of £700 be obtained for the completion of the Clonfert new road" was unanimously passed, and it was agreed that the Estates Commissioners be asked to contribute £350 to assist in the repair of this road.

Mr. Parker withdrew his notice of Motion " to rescind the resolution of the Council introducing Direct Labour into the District".

No action was taken on a resolution from the Lawrencetown Labourers' Association protesting against Mr. Parker's motion.

Mary Connolly wrote stating that part of her Cottage turf bank was being cut by Thos. Hardiman.

Thos. Hardiman wrote stating he was within his right in doing so.

The Council decided they had no power to interfere in the matter

Read a letter from the Local Government Board No L 7350 dated the 9th. July '17 requesting the Council to make definite orders on the Auditor's report, when Mr. Lynskey handed in the following notice of motion :- "I beg to give notice that I will move at the next meeting of the Council that a salary be fixed for Mr. J. L. Dunne, the Council's Engineer".

It was ordered that the Contractor for the repairs of the Cottages at Moaty be requested to carry out the work at once, and that the Solicitors to the Council proceed to execution of the Decree obtained against Michael Barry, another contractor for cottage repairs

The Collector Daniel Connolly was ordered to get a lock and key for Crowsnest Cottage occupied by Jno. Geraghty. He was further ordered to secure the door of the vacant cottage at Moaty and procure a lock and key for gate of plot.

Byrnes, and of whose money £47 - I was struck off".

Mr. T. P. Killeen proposed and Mr. Lyons seconded and unanimously resolved,

" That we the Ballinasloe NoI, R. D. Council condemn in the strongest manner the action of the eleven representatives on Galway County Council who at the last meeting voted for keeping a disgraceful resolution in reference to the 1916 Rebellion on the Minute Book of the Galway County Council, and we call on their constituents to take notice of their action ."
