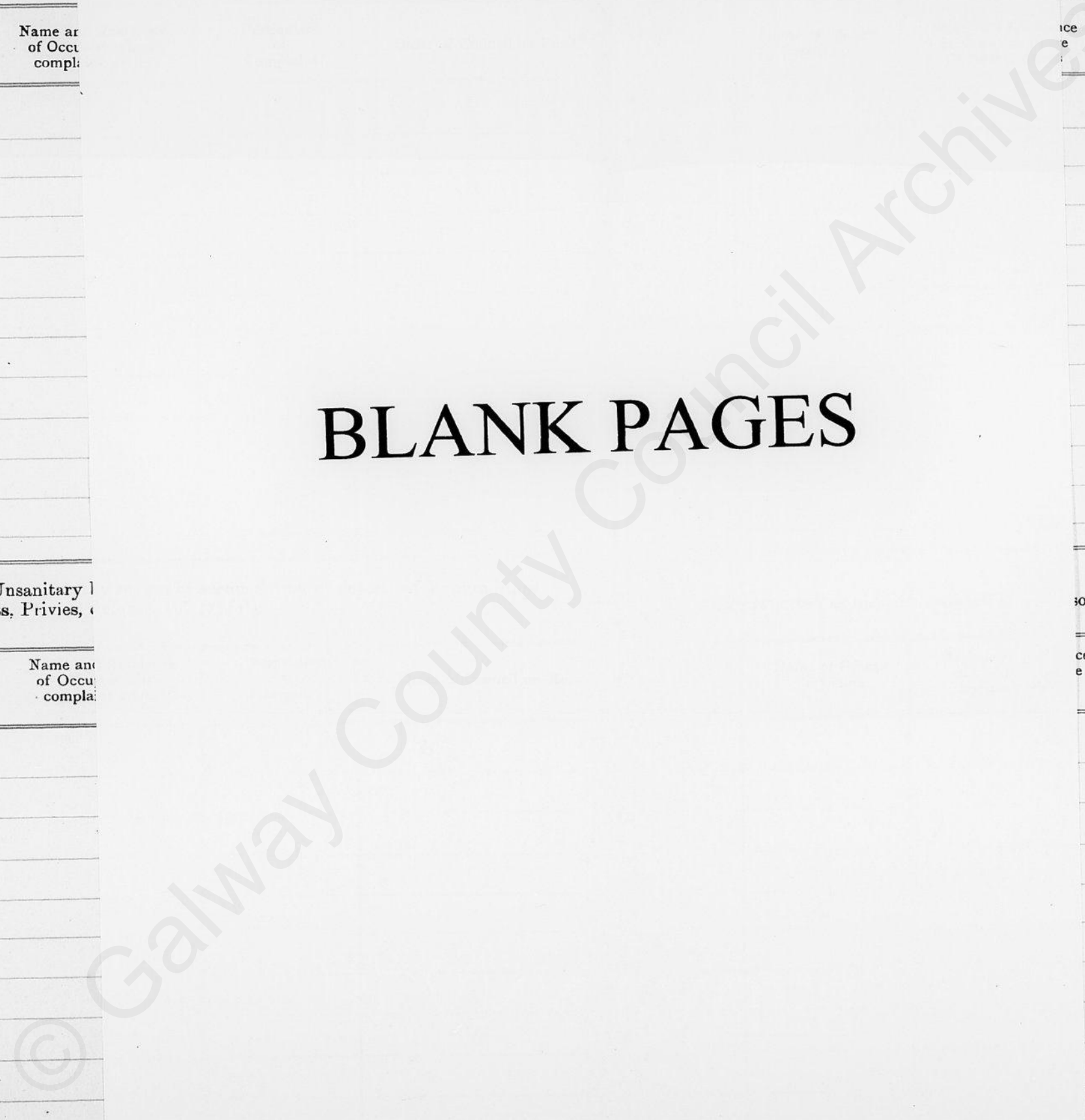

The Asst. Clerk submitted an account from Mr. T. Derrane, Contractor for repairs to Moore pump, for a sum of £2 : 5 and informed the Council that a sum of fifteen shillings had to be paid another Plumber for work which Contractor neglected to do.

It was decided to deduct the fifteen shillings from Contractor's amount.

Messrs Hayden & Taylor, the Council's Solicitors reported that a sum of £15 was allowed in the Potts Malicious Injury Claim, leviable on Rakarabeg.
