At the same time stating that the Council would do well to revise the form of advertisement of tenders in respect of printing contracts, so as to make it fuller and more definite. (REMISSION OF SURCHARGE).

Letter from the L.G.Board No 32545 dated the 18th June, 1914, forwarding for the information of the Council a copy of the Report of the Auditor on his audit of the accounts of the Council for the half year ended the 31st March, 1914, with an attested abstract of the Accounts.

Claffey, (C). M. Naughton, D. J. Finn, P. Claffey, (G). J. Caulfield, J. Kelly, M. Cahill, J. Flynn, (C). Thomas Ryan, J. Flynn, (M), and Thomas Kilduff.

"My reason for making the foregoing Surcharge is that at a Meeting held on the 12th April, 1913, there were two Tenders for Printing and Advertising for the year 1913 1914 for £12 10s. 0d, and £7 16s. 0d. The Members above-named being present at this Meeting accepted the Tender for £12 10s. 0d. thus causing a loss to the Ratepayers of £4 14s. 0d. for the year, or £3 10s. 6d. for the last three quarters, which was the amount paid during the period under Audit. In my opinion the Tender for £7 16s. 0d. should have been accepted, and I have accordingly surcharged the Members present at the above-mentioned Meeting who accepted this higher Tender.
