I am preparing Maps and Estimate to accompany application on your behalf to the Road Board for grant in aid of improvement by steam rolling the road leading from Ballinasloe to Athlone which forms part of the trunk road from Galway to Dublin and is one of the roads included in a list of roads towards the improvement of which the Road Board have promised to make free grants of half the cost of the improvement work.





and 3 Bad, and of those under Contract 1 was Good, 11 Fair and 4 Middling.

These three bad roads are receiving special attention, the contracts for their repair formerly were so reduced in price that it was found impossible to obtain their fulfilment. However, I hope to effect a considerable improvement in them by Direct Labour work.

I had intended recommending you to make proposal for half the estimated cost of improving, by steam-rolling, the road from Ballinasloe to Athlone with the view of obtaining free grant from the Road Board for the other half of the cost, but the reply given by the Road Board lately to my application for similar grant for the Athlone end of the same line of road suggested that the County Council might defer proceeding with expensive improvement work until more normal conditions obtain, and the Local Government Board are postponing their sanction of loans wherever they consider the work is not urgently required.





REPORT OF THE COUNTY SURVEYOR TO THE BALLINASLOE NO. 2 RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL FOR THE QUARTER ENDED 30th SEPTEMBER 1915.

Gentlemen,

Herewith I return Form 22 in which I have entered my recommendations for proposals for payment and other decisions which I consider should be made by you in dealing with the Quarterly Instalments of the Contract amounts.

The condition of the Public Works Contracts in the District is indicated by the recommendations in the Form from which may be seen that **add=ef** all of the Quarterly Instalments current for the Quarter now being dealt with may be paid in full, and the first molety of all instalments for Special Works for the present Quarter may also be paid.

At the time of recent inspection the condition of the surfaces of the roads was as follows:- Of those being maintained by Direct Labour 1 was Fair and 12 Middling, and

of those under Continuous Contract 2 were Fair and 14 Middling.

The work lately begun by Direct Labour 1s proceeding fairly well. Some little improvement work of surface shaping and drainage has been begun and I hope to effect a good deal of improvement in surface work this season.

We must defer for the present all consideration of improving roads by steam rolling as the Road Board funds have be been transferred to the National service Account and no grants will be made for any work which is not urgently necessary. We must only try to show on Ballinasloe District that roads of light traffic may be made to have a perfectly even surface by the ordinary patching system when properly carried out. I have in other Districts some lengths of roads maintained by Direct Labour on which the surface has been made perfectly even without any steam rolling. It is only on roads of heavy traffic and on roads which have either been let to wear out or were never properly surfaced that steamrolling is of use to prevent public inconvenience at times of laying on of the road material.
