I have been requested by the
widow and daughter of the late
Thomas Carroll (lately a member of your
Board) to express to you their sense of the
great honor you have paid his memory
by the adjournment of your board at its
last meeting. For tribute of respect paid
to the memory of a truly upright, respected
and honest man; and for your kind
letter of condolence which is most
consoling to those he has left behind, he
pleased to accept their heartfelt thanks.

As a connection of Mr. Carroll's
family it affords me pleasure to find
that the upright and manly conduct
that has characterized his course through
life has won for him your esteem.

opinion, that a large amount of
the pauperism and stagnation of
trade and business throughout
the County is partly the result of
the failure of the Land Act of 1881
to relieve the farmers from the
reaction of rents unjustly levied
upon their own improvements
Contrary to the spirit of the

Healthy Classes, and also by reason
of the want of the manufacturing
interests of Ireland being totally
neglected by the Government, and not
giving the skilled mechanic and
artisan an opportunity of competing
with foreign manufactures.

We therefore resolve to direct the
attention of the Legislature to the
pressing necessity of amending the
Land Act of 1881 in this Session of
Parliament now opened, by bringing
within the scope of that Act every holding
in Ireland whether held by lease or
otherwise and by giving definite
Legislative instructions to the rent
investigators of the future to exempt
all tenant property, no matter at
what time created from rent.

That this improved Legislature, will
leave so much money in the hands of
the working classes in Ireland, that
trade and business will be stimulated,
pauperism lessened, and the earning
capacity of the rate payers increased
to meet the inevitable burden of
Local Government"


