

**Medical Charities Act (14 & 15 Vic., cap. 68), Vaccination Acts,  
and Dispensary Houses Act.**

MINUTES of Proceedings of the Board of Guardians under the above-mentioned Acts, at a Meeting held on Wednesday the 1<sup>st</sup> day of September 1895.

An Estimate of Medicines, &c., required by the Medical Officer of the \_\_\_\_\_ Dispensary District, approved by the Committee of Management, was laid before the Board, with a Requisition from the Committee for the supply of the same, and directions were given thereon as follows:—

Read letter from Dr. C.H. Foley, of Staverstock Hill London, requesting payment of £7: 11: 0 for temporary medical officer of the Roundstone No. 2 Dispensary District during the illness of the medical officer of that District on the requisition of the medical officer of the dispensary. The undersigned again request the Roundstone Dispensary Committee to furnish a copy of the minutes with reference to Dr. Foley's appointment as temporary substitute for the medical officer of the above District. Dr. Foley's letter referred to them.
