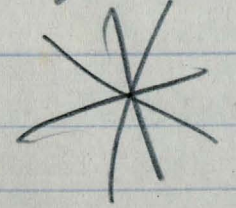

- (7) That the cost of mortgage & agreements be payable by borrowers and that same be deducted from the last instalment of the loan: Cost not to exceed £2.10.0 per case

8. All applicants to apply in a form to be issued by the Secretary: Copy of application form to be sent to all persons in respect of whom form A has been received ^{20th} whether they have applied for loans or not as many persons are not aware of the Act and Orders.

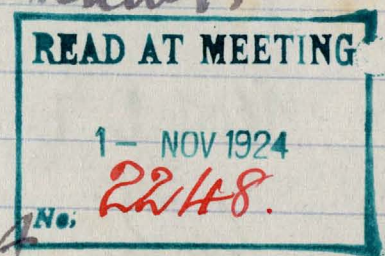
