INCREASE OF RENT AND MORTGAGE
(Restrictions) ACT, 1923.

Rates on unoccupied or Vacant Buildings.

Sir,
Hitherto it has been the practice to remit rates on vacant
dwelling houses on a declaration of vacancy being made.
The operation of the above Act renders premises under
£40 valuation liable to rates whether vacant or not,
(a) if the Buildings are valued separately & or
(b) if Buildings are in one valuation with land, and the
land is valued at less than one-fourth of the
Buildings.
In all such cases therefore rates must be recovered from
the person assessed.

Instructions to Road Gangers.

Gangers are to read carefully and memorise the following instructions which have been specially prepared for their use.
Working Hours:—The working day begins at 8 a.m., and ends at 6 p.m., with one hour for dinner, that is from 12 noon, to 1 p.m. On Saturdays the working day ends at 1 o'clock without any break for dinner.

Gangers to work with their men:—Gangers are to work with their men throughout the day and they are not to leave the men unless on very urgent business connected with the work.

If it is found at any time during the working day that a Ganger is away from his men or that he is idling his time looking at the men working or cycling or walking over the section without any urgent reason, his services will be dispensed with immediately.

Changing of Men:—Gangers will please note that maintenance work or re-construction work on Main roads is not relief work or work in which the people of a district are entitled to get a fortnights work in their turn. The Ganger is therefore to select from amongst the genuine labourers in the area in which his section is situated the best men he can get and he is to retain the services of these men, provided they give satisfaction, unless he receives a notice to the contrary from the County Surveyor.

Carters:—All genuine carters in the area—that is men who make a living on cart work, are to get a preference, and if such men are not available a preference is to be given to small farmers or labourers provided they have good horses and carts.

A Ganger is not to employ his son as a carter; neither is he to use his own cart on the work, unless he receives a written consent to do so from the County Surveyor.

Time Book and Pay Sheets:—The Ganger is to have his Time Book with him at all times during the working day so that all entries can be checked on the road. The men's time is to be entered accurately in the Time Book day by day, and at the end of each fortnight transferred to the Pay-Sheet. Stones or gravel purchased during any particular fortnight or any other services rendered during the fortnight for which payment is to be made are to be entered on the Pay-Sheet for that fortnight and also on the Time-Book with all necessary dimensions and particulars. On the Monday following the expiration of each fortnight the Pay-Sheet signed by the Ganger together with the fortnightly report form is to be posted to the Assistant Co. Surveyor. No Pay-Sheet will be forwarded by the County Surveyor to the County Secretary's office for payment unless the Ganger's fortnightly report is attached, accurately filled, signed, and dated.

in regard to simultaneous D^r + Cr. Balances but they cannot agree to the stipulation that the number of accounts must be limited to two. Any private individual may open as many bank accounts as his business requires, at a cost of half a guinea a year for each account and Public Bodies must be allowed the like freedom.

The Galway County Council require for purposes of Account and Audit the following Accounts:

Subsidiary
Trunk Roads.
Loan Account.

Any attempt to merge these accounts will inevitably lead to confusion and inconvenience to the Council and their Staff + the Auditors of the Ministry.

If the "two current accounts" limitation were enforced, the Council may be compelled to divide their accounts between the four banks in Galway so as to retain the accounts they require for the convenient conduct of their business, and yet have not more than two accounts at any bank.

The ~~Council~~^{Committee} consider that the Poor Rate Account in Urban Districts should be kept strictly distinct from other Urban Council monies; otherwise the prompt meeting of the County Demand may be endangered. ~~It~~ it will almost certainly be endangered in Co. Galway.

The Banking returns, and the dividends paid by the Banks, make it quite clear that there is no justification for the attempt of

~~The Irish Banks standing Committee first, by an accounting device, to extract an unfair interest from Irish Public Bodies whose accounts showed simultaneous D^r + Cr. ESTIMATES.

Dear Sir,

I am directed by the Finance Committee to call the attention of Representatives of the County Council on Spending Bodies and Committees to the fact that these Bodies, financed by the County Council out of the rates, will shortly be considering their estimates and demands for the year ending March, 1927. From public references to the finances of these Bodies which have lately been appearing, it seems to the Finance Committee that the public are being gradually prepared for heavy increases in the demands to be made upon the County Council.

The Committee, therefore, think it desirable to inform you that, in their opinion, the attitude which should be adopted towards the tendency of increased demands is one of **continual and determined resistance**. The Committee, however, realise that there is little use in merely reducing estimates unless, at the same time, (1) definite instructions are given to the Principal Executive Officers of the Spending Bodies to keep their expenditure within the prescribed limits, and (2) that whatever power may be necessary to enable the responsible Executives to carry out this instruction should be given. Mere general statements about the necessity for economy are of very little use. The actual working of the Institutions must be carefully scrutinised, and the overhead charges, where possible, be reduced either by reduction of staffs or otherwise. There is reason to believe that there is considerable waste in connection with the issue of stores, provisions, fuel, etc.

The Finance Committee desire to direct your attention to the fact that the rate for the year ending March, 1927, will be the first rate of the present Council, and that it is desirable that the estimates should prove to the Ratepayers that the County Council have done all in their power to make the call on the Ratepayers as light as possible.

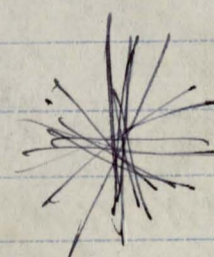

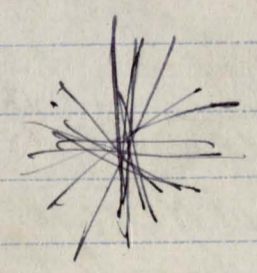

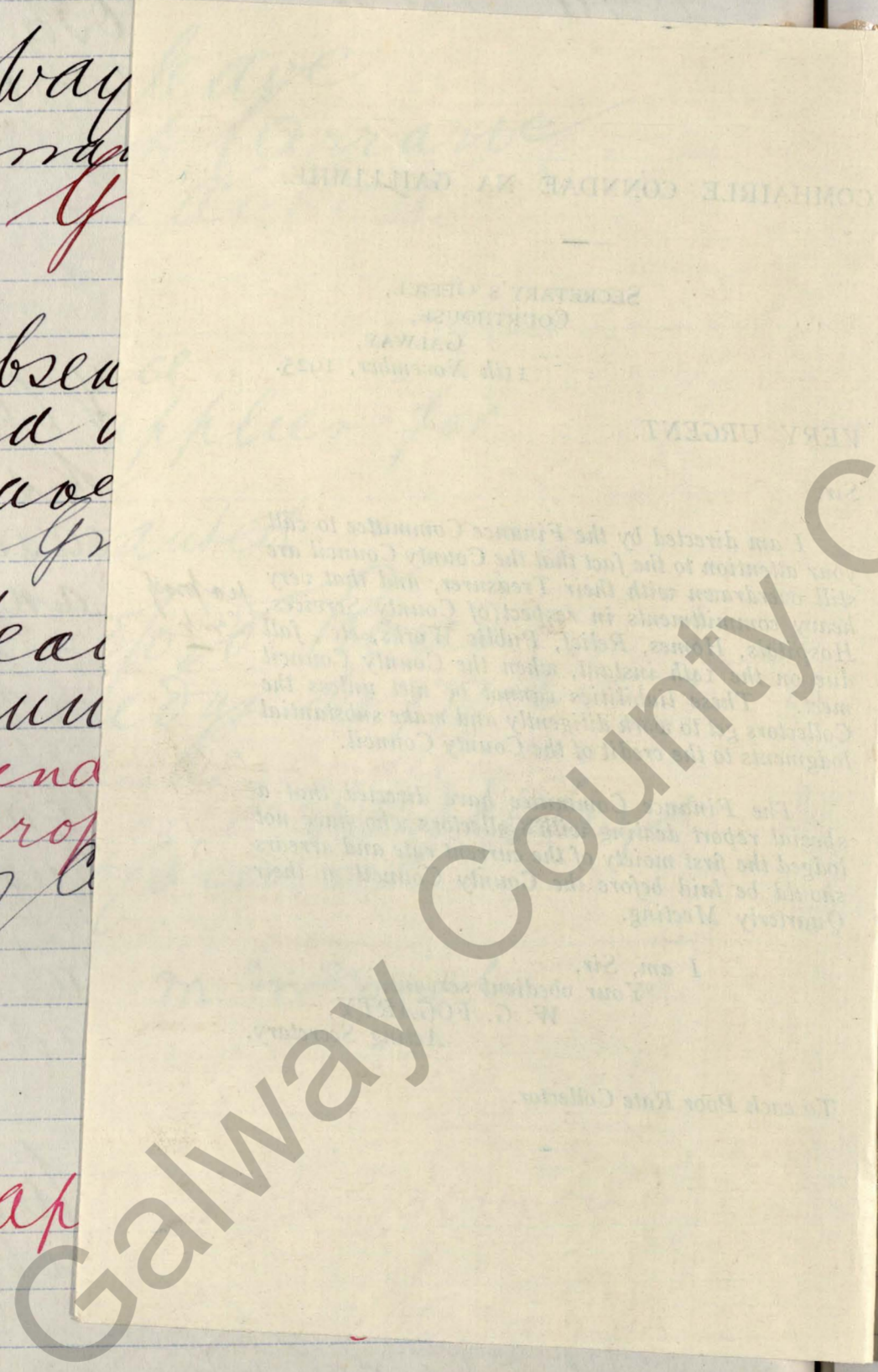
