As there are only seven weeks of the current half-year unexpired the Finance Committee consider that all Collectors under 15 per cent. at this time are unsatisfactory.

Sir,

I am directed by the Finance Committee to call the attention of Rate Inspectors and Poor Rate Collectors to Articles 92 to 109 of the Public Bodies Order, 1925.

From the Reports of the Rate Inspectors it frequently appears that a Rate Collector did not attend for fortnightly checking, and the explanation is given that the Collector states "he did not collect any money during the fortnight," or it is reported that the Collector did not produce the Warrants for ALL Electoral Divisions in his District in which case the explanation offered is "that the Collector states he collected no money in the other Electoral Divisions." The Finance Committee desire to draw the attention of Rate Collectors and Rate Inspectors to the fact that, the Public Bodies Order prescribes the method by which the collection, or non-collection, of money is to be ascertained, and that that method is THE ACTUAL CHECKING OF THE WARRANTS INTO THE ABSTRACTS BY THE RATE INSPECTOR.

The recent decision "Fraher v. the Waterford County Council" shows the extreme importance of strict attention to the provisions of the Public Bodies Order.

Collectors are accordingly informed that, in future, cases in which a satisfactory explanation is not given or where there is default on two successive examination dates, the Collector will be reported to the Minister, to his Sureties, and to the County Council.
