I am directed by the Minister for Local Government and Public Health to state that it has been represented to him by the Land Commission that before payments of Poor Rates can be made by that Department it has to satisfy itself that it is liable in respect of the Demands made, and that this in many cases necessitates a reference being made to local Inspectors, who in all cases deal with the Demands as quickly as possible. In order to avoid incurring unnecessary travelling expenses the Land Commission Inspectors are not always in a position to return the Demands within the comparatively short periods sometimes allowed for the payment of the 1st moiety of the Rates. I am, therefore, to request the County Council to issue a circular to their Rate Collectors instructing them to serve all Demands for Rates on the Land Commission at the earliest possible date after the striking of the Rates. This would not only facilitate the passing of Demands for payment by the Land Commission, or where the Land Commission is found not to be liable, the return of the Demand Note; but would considerably reduce the Rate Collector's work and enable him as far as the Land Commission is concerned to close his warrants without loss of poundage.

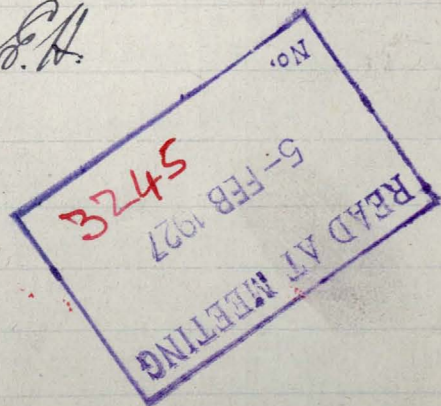
