S. Walsh and the remainder as per the Manager's Report, Community Facilities,(13.4 acres) and Recreational & Amenity(10 acres)

Cllr Healy Eames proposed to accept the recommendation in the Manager's Report. She stated that Oranmore community needs lands for recreational and amenity and community facilities. She added that there was broad agreement in the community that these 30.4 acres were ideally located and were needed to match the current and future population needs of Oranmore and she stated that it was also echoed in the numerous submissions received from the public in relation to general Community Facilities issues.

It was proposed by Cllr McDonagh and seconded by Cllr Mullins to zone 3.9 acres of the lands the subject of Submission 7A residential and the remainder of the lands Community Facilities

Cllr Mannion stated that there was no consistency with these proposals. He added that the decisions taken should not reflect the ownership of the lands. He added that decisions must be made effectively and properly

Cllr Regan stated that it was totally unacceptable to zone this land as the owner did not make a submission to the Draft Plan.

Cllr Cuddy stated that the owner should at least have been consulted.

Mr Gavin stated that the aim of the Planning Authority was to achieve adequate zoned lands in Oranmore for recreation and amenity and community facilities.

Cllr McHugh stated that the Council should take a % from each landowner whose lands are zoned and this will then enable this Authority to acquire adequate funds to purchase blocks of land for community facilities etc.

Water Schemes

Cllr. O' Cuaig referred to the Carna/Kilkieran Regional Water Supply Scheme and asked if there was any further information in relation to side roads, details of which he had submitted, which were not included in the Scheme.

Mr. Cullen said that the scheme consisted of 59km of trunk and distribution water mains laid primarily in regional road R340 and the estimated cost of the scheme was over €11m. He said that 5 spur roads had been included in the original preliminary report and a further 13 added afterwards. The basis for including the additional roads was the number of properties, their elevation, the length of the road and economic feasibility of serving each house and representations received by the Council from people in the area. He said that an assessment had been made of the 11 side roads that had been indicated on the map submitted at the last Council meeting, and the cost of extending the scheme to them was estimated at €1,016,562. He said the Council would make a submission to the Department for approval to extend the scheme but was not optimistic that it would be approved. If it was not approved, the owners of the properties might wish to look at the possibility of a group scheme.

Comh. O Cuaig stated that the EIS for the Cashla Regional Water Supply Scheme was delayed and he had been informed that it would not be going to An Bord Pleanála until November. He said he was disappointed with this and asked if parts of the scheme such as pipeworks or reservoirs could proceed separately.

Mr. Cullen stated that a section of pipe work from Cashla Cross to Screebe Cross was being tendered as part of the Camus Group Water Supply Scheme and approval will be sought to go ahead with that when tenders are received for the Camus Scheme. He said that it would not be possible to do any reservoir or

intake works. He said the site investigation contract had been advertised for the whole scheme recently and that a report was needed for the preparation of contract documents. At that stage an assessment can be made about other sections of pipeline and whether they could proceed separately from the main Scheme.

Galway County Council are committed to compliance with the requirements of this agreement including notifying Unions, which are party to the agreement, of the award of any relevant contract.

All Department of the Council have been issued with a copy of the Agreement for its implementation. There is a procedure in place which is designed to give the Unions the appropriate notification and this information is supplied by the relevant Department of the Council on the awarding of the contract. The Council is currently reviewing its processes to ensure that it fully meets its obligation in relation to this matter.
