As no accommodation could possibly be procured for the Caretaker and her family it was necessary to obtain accommodation for them in the Galway Union, and the account for their maintenance there, as well as for any damages ascertained to have been done to the Hospital &c during the period of military occupation had been furnished to the Authorities, but as no meeting had been held no claim had yet been

made for the use of the Hospital Buildings, and the meeting were asked to fix the amount of the claim.

It was decided that a claim for £150 be furnished for use of the Hospital during the period of Military occupation, as had a case of disease occurred requiring treatment in the Hospital the joint Committee would be very seriously affected had they to provide accommodation.

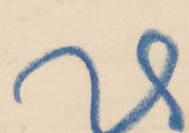

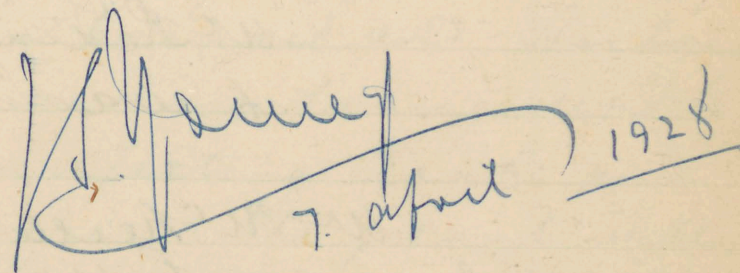
