Experience shows that rates tend to be higher in urban districts than in towns which are not urban districts because in the latter case the sanitary services/ charges are spread over the entire county health district. I would not recommend the Town Commissioners to seek Urban District Countil status."

On the Proposition of Mr. Carty, Chairman, Seconded by Mr. Devine ithe Boardenhammously agreed with the Co. Manager's proposal to ask the County Council to take over the Public Lighting of the town of Loughrea.

Housing Charges— On the Proposition of the Chairman Seconded by Mr. Devine it was suggested that the Minister for Local Government be written to regarding Housing Charges within the township of Loughrea and inform him that as well as providing houses for the needs of the town the Board also relieved the Co. Council by housing tenants from outside the area.
