Galway County Council has undertaken an Appropriate Assessment (AA) Screening to assess, in view of best scientific knowledge and the conservation objectives of relevant European sites, if the proposed Electric fishing Surveys: Galway to Oughterard Greenway Project ('the proposed development') individually or in combination with other plans or projects would be likely to have a significant effect(s) on a European site(s).

The proposed development includes the following:

 Electric fishing surveys to be carried out at 16 sites alongside the emerging preferred route currently being considered in the Phase 3 Preliminary Design.

An Appropriate Assessment (AA) Screening is also required by Inland Fisheries Ireland (IFI) in order to grant authorisation for a section 14 permit to allow for the electric fishing activities.

The AA Screening Report states that in view of best available scientific knowledge and on the basis of objective information, likely significant effects from the Proposed Works on European sites, either alone or in-combination with other plans or projects, can be excluded.

Galway County Council, having considered the AA Screening Report, has determined that the Proposed Electric Fishing Surveys, relating to the Galway to Oughterard Greenway Project do not require an Appropriate Assessment.
