What's the Green Hi-Viz for?

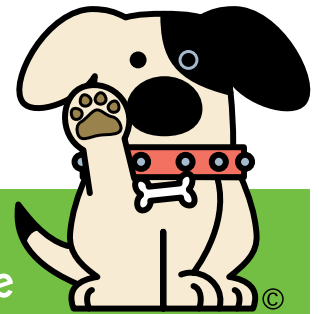
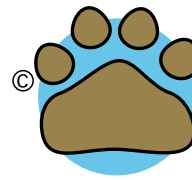
If you see someone wearing the Green Dog Walkers® Hi-Viz Vest it means they have "Taken the Pledge"

However, it IS SAFE to clean it up 'on the spot'!

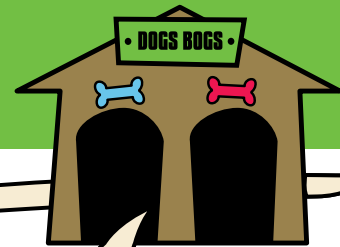


The Green Dog Walkers® Pledge
