NOTICE OF THE CONFIRMATION BY AN BORD PLEANÁLA OF A COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 76 OF AND THE THIRD SCHEDULE TO THE HOUSING ACT, 1966, AS EXTENDED BY SECTION 10 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (NO. 2)

ACT, 1960, (AS SUBSTITUTED BY SECTION 86 OF THE HOUSING ACT, 1966) AS RESPECTS ALL OR PART OF THE LAND TO WHICH THE COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER RELATES, TO BE PUBLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 78 (1) OF THE HOUSING ACT, 1966, AS AMENDED BY THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACTS, 2000 (AS AMENDED); HOUSING ACTS, 1966 (AS AMENDED); ROADS ACTS, 1993 (AS AMENDED); LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACTS, 1925 (AS AMENDED); AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT REFORM ACT, 2014 (AS AMENDED).

COMPULSORY ACQUISITION OF LAND

N63 LISS TO ABBEY REALIGNMENT SCHEME COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER NO. 1 2021 (Roads & Transportation)

AN BORD PLEANÁLA has, on the 25th day of May 2023, made a Confirmation Order confirming the above-named Compulsory Purchase Order without modifications as respects the land described in the Schedules, for the purpose of road construction in the townlands of Culliagh South, Culliagh North, Liss, Chapelfield, Abbey, Clashard, Moyne and Newtown in County Galway. The said order, as so confirmed, authorises Galway County Council to acquire the said land compulsorily.

A copy of the Order as so confirmed and of the map showing the location of the lands may be seen at the offices of:

Between the hours of:

9.30am to 1:00pm and 2:00pm to 4.00pm from **Wednesday 26th July 2023 to
Friday 22nd September 2023**, inclusive of both dates (excluding public holidays).

The Order also authorises Galway County Council to extinguish the public rights of way described in the Schedules, by order made by them, after they have acquired the said land.

The Order, as so confirmed will become operative at the expiration of three weeks after the date of publication of this notice, but if an application for judicial review of the decision of An Bord Pleanála under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986) is duly made to the High Court within eight weeks of the date of publication of this notice in accordance with Section 50 of the Planning & Development Act 2000, as amended, the Court-

- (a) May by interim order suspend the operation of the Compulsory Purchase Order as so confirmed either generally or in so far only as it affects any property of the applicant until the final determination of the proceedings.
- (b) If satisfied upon the hearing of the application that the Compulsory Purchase Order as so confirmed is not within the powers of the Housing Act, 1966 as extended by Section 10 of the Local Government (No. 2) Act, 1960 (as substituted by Section 86 of the Housing Act 1966), as so extended and amended, not having been complied with, may quash the Order as so confirmed either generally or in so far only as it affects any property of the applicant.
