Notice of Decision

Notice is hereby given that Galway County Council has made an order closing the following route daily from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. This closure will be in effect from Monday 4th February 2019 to 4:30 p.m. on Friday 15th March 2019 to facilitate re-surfacing work and excavation of the existing road in places.

- N84 on the Headford to Shrle Section - 1 km section at Bunnaconeen, from North of the Junction with the L6127 (to Kinlough Castle and Church) to Tonroe, South of the Junction with the L6132 (to Knockroone/Cloonee/Lisdonagh).

Alternative route:

North Bound traffic should divert in Headford onto the R334 (Ballinrobe Road) to Glencorrib and then turn right onto the L1615 to Shrle.

South Bound traffic should divert South of Shrle onto the L2104 (towards Caherlistrane) and then onto the R333 (at Queally's public house) to Headford.

Routes will be sign posted.
