Notice is hereby given that Galway County Council has made an order closing the following route from **8:00 a.m. on Monday, 19th February, 2018 to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, 23rd March, 2018** to facilitate the construction of a new watermain as part of the Castlerea & Environs Water Supply Scheme.

- R327 from junction of L1602 (Lowberry Cross) to junction of R360 (Pollredmond Cross)

Alternative Route

- Please divert from Pollredmond Cross on R360 towards Dunmore, onto N83 towards Cloonfad turning onto the R327 to Lowberry Cross thus completing the diversion and vice versa

Notice is hereby given that Galway County Council has made an order closing the following route from **8:00 a.m. on Monday, 19th February, 2018 to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, 9th March, 2018** to facilitate the construction of a new watermain as part of the Castlerea & Environs Water Supply Scheme.

- Local road exiting Williamstown towards Ballymoe on R360, local road up towards Williamstown Water Tower

Alternative Route

- At closure of local road exiting Williamstown on the R360 to Ballymoe, please divert via further on R360 to alternative entrance to local road and vice versa

Notice is hereby given that Galway County Council has made an order closing the following route from **8:00 a.m. on Monday, 19th March, 2018 to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, 27th April, 2018** to facilitate the construction of a new watermain as part of the Castlerea & Environs Water Supply Scheme.

- R360 from junction of R327 (Pollredmond Cross) to junction of L2201 (Kilnalag Cross)

Alternative Route

- Please divert from R360 entering Williamstown, turn onto the R361 and continue onto Castlerea turning left onto the N60 and continue onto Ballyhaunis and turning left onto the N83 and continue onto Cloonfad. In Cloonfad turn left onto the R327 to complete diversion and alternative route is vice versa.

Diversion signage will be in place.
