**INIS OÍRR HARBOUR BYE-LAWS 2021-2022**

Notice is hereby given that **Galway County Council** intends to make Bye-Laws pursuant to Part 19 of the Local Government Act, 2001 as amended, and Part 2 of the Maritime Safety Act, 2005, and Sections 13, 89 and the sixth schedules to the Harbours Act 1966 as amended. The general purpose of these Bye-Laws is the regulation of Inis Oírr Harbour, Inis Oírr, Árann, Co.Galway.

These Bye-laws contain a provision for payment of a specified amount as an alternative to prosecution, for contravention of these Bye-Laws as provided by section 206 of the Local Governments Act 2001.
