

## SITE NOTICE

### Application to Galway County Council for a Waste Facility Permit Bruscar Bhearna Teoranta, Headford Road, Galway, Co. Galway

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Articles 7 and 8 of the Waste Management (Facility Permit and Registration) Regulations 2007 (as amended) that Bruscar Bhearna Teoranta of Carrowbrowne, Headford Road, Galway, Co. Galway intends to apply for a Waste Facility Permit to Operate a Waste Transfer Facility at Pollboy, Ballinasloe, Co. Galway. The application for a Waste Facility Permit to Operate a Waste Transfer Facility will be made to Galway County Council within 10 working days of the date of this notice.

The Class(es) of Activity at the site, as specified in the Third and Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act, 1996, are as follows:

<b>Number of Class</b>	<b>Class Description</b>
<b>D15</b> <b>(Principle Activity)</b>	Storage pending any of the operations numbered D1 to D14(excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of 'collection' in section 5(1), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced))
<b>D13</b>	Blending or mixture prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D12 (if there is no other D code appropriate, this can include preliminary operations prior to disposal including pre-processing such as, amongst others, sorting, crushing, compacting, pelletising, drying, shredding, conditioning or separating prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D12)
<b>D14</b> <b>Number of Class</b> <b>R3</b>	<b>Class Description</b> Repackaging prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D13 Recycling/reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes), which includes gasification and pyrolysis using the components as chemicals
<b>R12</b>	Exchange of waste for submission to any of the operations numbered R1 to R11 (if there is no other R code appropriate, this can include preliminary operations prior to recovery including pre-processing such as, amongst others, dismantling, sorting, crushing, compacting, pelletising, drying, shredding, conditioning, repackaging, separating, blending or mixing prior to submission to any of the operations numbered R1 to R11)
<b>R13</b>	Storage of waste pending any of the operations number R1 to R12 (excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of 'collection' in section 5(1), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced)

The Class(es) of Activity at the site, as specified in Part 1 of the third Schedule of the Waste Management (Facility Permit and Registration) Regulations 2007 (as amended) is/are as follows;

<b>Number of Class</b>	<b>Class Description</b>
<b>Class 7</b>	Recovery of inert waste arising from the construction and demolition activity, including concrete, bricks, tiles, or other such similar material, at a facility (Excluding land improvements or development) Where- (a) the annual intake does not exceed 50,000 tonnes, and (b) the maximum quantity of residual waste consigned from the facility for collection, onward transport and submission to disposal at an authorised facility shall not exceed 15% of the annual intake.
<b>Class 10</b> <b>(Principle Activity)</b>	The recovery of waste (not mentioned elsewhere in this part of the third schedule), other than hazardous waste or an activity where there is a scheduled requirement to hold an IPPC licence or a waste licence, where- (a) the annual intake does not exceed 50,000 tonnes, and (b) the maximum quantity of residual waste consigned from the facility for onward transport and submission to disposal at an authorised facility shall not exceed 15% of the annual intake.
<b>Class 11</b>	The reception, storage and transfer of waste (other than hazardous waste) for disposal at a facility (other than a landfill facility) where the annual intake does not exceed 7,500 tonnes

It is an offence for any person other than the applicant, his/her agent, Galway County Council or the Environmental Protection Agency to remove this site notice.

A copy of the application for the waste facility permit will be available for inspection or purchase, as soon as is practicable after receipt by Galway County Council, at the principal offices of Galway County Council, Environment Section, Liosbaun Industrial Estate, Galway.
