# **CSO Release Household Travel Survey 2012**

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### **Domestic Trips**

- Domestic trips fell by 1.9% in 2012
- Irish residents took just over 7 million domestic trips in 2012 with an average stay of 2.9 nights and a total value of €1.3 billion
- Just less than half of the domestic trips were classed as holidays while a third were visits to friends or relatives.
- The most popular mode of transport used was by private vehicle at 88% followed by bus or rail at 10%.

### **Outbound Trips**

- Outbound travel fell by 1.2%
- 6.6 million outbound trips were taken in 2012.
- 86% of these were within the EU
- The average night stay was 8 nights
- Just over half of the trips were for holidays and just under a quarter were for visiting friends or relatives.
  - The UK was the most popular country to visit, followed by Spain and then France.

# **County Galway Live Register Figures**

The Live Register is **not** designed to measure unemployment as it includes part-time, seasonal and casual workers entitled to Jobseekers Allowance or Jobseekers Benefit. The live register is complied from returns made from each local Social Welfare office.

# Births, Deaths & Marriage Stats 2012

#### Births

- There were 72,225 births registered in 2012 with 37,210 males and 35,015 females, a decrease of 3.5% on 2011.
- The average age of mothers for births registered in 2012 was 31.9 years. Almost 2/5's of births in 2012 were to first time mothers where the average age was 29.9 years. Over a third (35%) of births in 2012 were outside of marriage with almost 57% of the births outside marriage to cohabiting parents.
- Births to mothers of Irish nationality accounted for over three-quarters (76%) of the births in 2012. A further 2.2% of births were to mothers of UK nationality, with 1.4% born to mothers from EU15 countries excluding Ireland and the UK. Over 11% of births were born to mothers from the Accession states (EU27 excl. EU 15) and 8.2% to mothers from non EU countries. The remaining 1.2% of births did not state a nationality for the mother.

#### Deaths

- There were 28,848 deaths registered in 2012, a decrease of 0.5% on 2011.
- 32% of deaths were due to diseases of the circulatory system, 30% were cancer related and 12% were from diseases of the respiratory system. Deaths due to accidents, suicide and other external causes accounted for a further 6% of all deaths.
- There were 507 suicides registered in 2012. This compares with 525 suicides registered in 2011, a decrease of 3.5%. Figures for 2012 shows a decrease (of 6%) in male suicides from 2011. Males accounted for 81% of all suicide deaths in 2012.
- The natural increase (births minus deaths) in 2012 was 43,377, a decrease of 5% on the 2011 figure.

### Marriages

 There were 21,245 marriages registered in 2012 which was 1,366 or 6% more than in 2011. The number of divorces granted by the Circuit Court and the High Court was 2,892 which was an increase of 73 on the 2011 figure.
